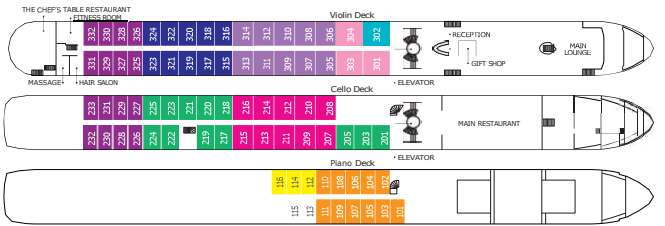

Since 1984, he has also been Artistic Director of the Irving M. Klein International String Competition, one of the most prominent music competitions in the world.
